GUIDELINES

1. ALL TREES MUST BE ARTIFICIAL (fire regulation) and have a proper stand for an artificial tree. Don't forget tree skirts.
2. Participants are encouraged to use creativity with decorations that reflect their business or organization. No edible decorations, please.
3. NO giveaways or take-homes (candy, decorations, etc.) from trees or under trees.
4. Space is limited to 4 ft. from center of tree.
5. Please notify tree chair people of any unusual design or set-up.
6. Tree lights (preferably small) should be part of the decorations. NO BLINKING LIGHTS. NO SPOTLIGHTS. NO GLITTER! We have extension cords.
7. Tree sizes must be stated on the registration form. This helps tree chair people with placement decisions.
8. Museum will be open December 2nd (2- 5), December 3rd (10-5), and December 4th (10 - 7) for set-up and decoration. Dec. 16th (3-6) and 17th (10 - 7) are the dates for dismantling trees.
